#### General Circular 1 of 2021

### Dear parents

Welcome to Unicorn Preparatory in 2021!

In light of the recent surges in Covid-19 cases in South Africa, and the subsequent government change back to Level 3, we have been advised by ISASA that it would be better to delay the start of the academic year to Monday, 18 January 2021. However, in the best interests of our own school, we have decided to only allow Grades R, 1 and back a little earlier (14 & 15 January 2021) so that they can settle in. (Please see table below for all details).

# Grades 2, 3, 5, 6 and 7 will start on Monday, 18 January 2021.

There will obviously be some changes in our start of year programme. We have tried to keep these to a minimum for least disruption but in an endeavour to keep the safety of all our pupils and staff paramount, it is necessary to make some changes.
